The key elements of the role will be to provide relevant and timely advice to people who face complicated life challenges, working collaboratively within the community to embed first step support at a neighbourhood level. The post holder will work as part of the existing teams in the two centres supporting local residents to address complex life challenges that they are experiencing by providing information advice and guidance whilst linking them into other specialist agencies where necessary.

The post holder will work closely with the DIAL team and other local agencies. This will ensure that the provision of specialist and community-based support is integrated, reducing confusion amongst vulnerable people who are trying to access help and support.

Where not already held the successful candidate will be upskilled to achieve an Institute of Money Advisors accreditation.
